The way we were – 1981 The Brothers Glenny



This time our photo was taken on the evening of the Installation of Bro John Clark Glenny (left) into the Chair of No XII. He is pictured with his brother, Alistair, who was his Worshipful Senior Warden. In due course, Alistair followed Jack into the Chair. I believe that they are the only 'blood brothers' to have held the Chair in No XII. It must be quite an uncommon occurrence in the Craft in general for brothers to follow one another into the Chair. I wonder if it is unique?.

From the old Minute Books of No XII



This edition's Minute Book extract takes us back to 1895 and its subject is Bro DFD Neill, one of No XII's most eminent members. Bro Duncan Ferguson Dempster Neill was a sugar refiner whose family owned a refinery at 78 Drumfrochar Road. He went on to RWM of No XII in 1905.

DFD Neill rose to the rank of Colonel in the Royal Engineers and was awarded the DSO by His Majesty's Imperial Forces and the Croix de Guerre by the French in the Great War. He was an eminent and highly skilled yachtsman, so much so that he became Sir Thomas Lipton's right hand man in all of his attempts to win The Americas Cup. He is shown on the left hand side of the photograph. The other yachtsman in the white topped hat is Sir Thomas Lipton himself and they are on Shamrock III in 1910. Bro Neill passed to the Grand Lodge Above on 19th April 1938.

Wednesday 10th April 1895

The Secretary then read an application for admission to the Lodge from:-Duncan Ferguson Dempster Neill aged 26 Sugar Refiner, born and residing in Greenock

Candidate duly Elected and Initiated

The Candidate was proposed and seconded by Bros Alex Smith DM and Walter WB Rodger PM and after being balloted for was declared duly elected. He was thereupon prepared and initiated into the mysteries of the EA Degree.

Bro Neill passed into FC Degree

The Lodge was thereafter passed to the Fellow Craft Degree and Bro Neill was passed into that Degree.

There are a few things in this extract from the Minutes that we would find curious. Firstly, the Depute Master was presiding in the Chair, something that I have never seen in 43 years in the Craft. Next the meeting is being held on a Wednesday. Finally, Bro Neill's application was read, his ballot was held and he was Initiated and Passed all on the same night! This would be inconceivable these days.
