A Dip into our History

Meeting on Monday 26th October 1936

RWM Bro Peter R Jacobs in the Chair

Raised in Lodge Crawfurdsburn on 13th October Bros Anderson, McBride and Houstoun

A letter was read from Lodge Crawfurdsburn No 1121 in response to a requisition from the Master and Wardens of Lodge Greenock Kilwinning, the following Fellowcraft Brethren were raised the Sublime Degree of Master Mason:- Bros John Anderson, Angus McBride and Hugh Rough Houston. The necessity for this arrangement was owing to the Saloon of the Town Hall being otherwise engaged on the 13th October and our desire to meet the wishes of two of the foregoing brethren before they went abroad. At the request of the Master of Lodge Crawfurdsburn, the ceremonial work was carried out by our office bearers.
