The Anchor Lodge of Research No 1814 Visit

Our Meeting of 17th December – Annual Divine Service

The Lodge had around 60 brethren in attendance for the Annual Divine Service. It was again held in the Saloon of the Town Hall. After conducting some items of business with the brethren of No XII, RWM Bro Alan Beck welcomed a deputation of 18 visiting Brethren from within and out-with the Province headed by Bro William Lawson, RWM of Lodge Doric Kilwinning No 68 and accompanied by Bro Marshall North, RWM of Lodge Greenock St John's No 175, Bro Gerard Robertson, RWM of Lodge Cumberland Kilwinning No 217, Bro Andrew Piggot, RWM of Lodge Firth of Clyde Gourock No 626 and Bro Joseph Fogarty, RWM of Lodge Inverkip Ardgowan No 1425 who were invited to the East. RWM Bro Alan Beck then welcomed a deputation of 14 Brethren from the Provincial Grand Lodge of Renfrewshire West headed by the Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master Bro James P. Livingstone who took his rightful place in the East along with his commissioned Office Bearers. After the RWPGM had received and returned the James S Adams Memorial Gavel the lodge was put in recess.

At this point, the families of the brethren were admitted. In this innovation, the RWM had extended the invitation to friends and family to further enhance the inclusiveness of the Lodge and bring our families into our life and work.

Bro Jack Glenny, a Past Master of No XII, led the Divine Service. As a Reader of The Church of Scotland, Jack has conducted services around the country. In 2009, Jack was invited to address the Scottish Parliament at their "Time for Reflection" which they hold at the beginning of each new session. Jack was Moderator of the Greenock and Paisley Presbytery in 2006. The Scripture Readings from Amos 7: 7-9 and Matthew 13: 13-16 were delivered by Bro Robert J Bain IPM. The theme for Bro Jack's sermon, taken from the readings, was 'The Plumbline' and it was most thought provoking and spiritually uplifting. We were reminded of how our upright actions as members of the Craft had a positive influence on society and how we must ensure that the positive light of freemasonry shines out to make our world a better place.

Thereafter, we all sat down to a special festive supper prepared by our president of Stewards Bro Tony Buckley. It was so pleasant to be in harmony not just with our brethren but with the families too. From the old minute books of No XII

The extract below is interesting for a number of reasons. The new RWM Bro RL Scott has missed his first meeting in the Chair because of the death of his Mother. The Festival of St John the Evangelist is being celebrated in No XII, as in the other Lodges in the Province and beyond. The RWM's friend, Bro Playfair, is being Installed into the Chair of his affiliate Lodge in Fife just a couple of weeks after Bro RL Scott himself was installed into the Chair in No XII.

We heard about Bro Playfair from Bro Drew McKenzie PM (Crawfurdsburn Greenock No 1121) when he gave us his Lecture on RL Scott a couple of years ago in the Lodge.

The festival of St John the Evangelist used to have great importance in No XII and in other Scottish Lodges. A wee Google on the Internet will give you much more information on this topic ...

Thereupon Bro Neill made reference in most sympathetic terms to the bereavement which had fallen on the family of the RW Master (*Bro RL Scott*), through the death of his Mother, and it was agreed to record in the Minutes the deep sympathy felt by the Brethren for the RW Master and his Brother Mr. Chas C Scott and the Secretary was instructed to intimate same to them.

Deputations Despatched and received.

Deputations were despatched to visit Lodges No 68, Doric Kilwinning, No 175, Gnk St John, No 217, Cumberland Kilwinning, No 626, Firth of Clyde, and No 989, 'Sir Michael' Kilmacolm. In the course of the evening Deputations were received from the same lodges and also from No 370, Renfrew County Kilwinning and No 624 Montgomerie Kilwinning Skelmorlie.

The Lodge was then called from Labour to refreshment and the Toasts customary to the occasion were duly given and honoured. The health of Bro Major Playfair who was today being Installed as RWM of Lodge No 91 Leven, Fifeshire, was proposed by Bro Neill and was most heartily responded to. Bro Wm Gray responded on behalf of Bro Playfair as he was the RWM when Bro Playfair was initiated. The Secretary was instructed to inform Bro Playfair of what had been done
