Wednesday 5th March 1913

Presentation to Bro George Allan Treasurer on occasion of his marriage

An interesting part of the evening's proceedings was the presentation of a cabinet and a silver salver to Bro George Allan, Treasurer, to mark the occasion of his marriage in Decr. past. The presentation was made by Bro WG Buchanan PM who spoke in laudatory terms of Bro Allan and the excellent manner in which he carried out his duties in connection with the Lodge.

Reference to the death of Rev John Frew

Before the business of the Lodge was started, the RW Master made sympathetic reference to the death of the Bro the Revd. John Frew at Drighlington, Yorkshire. Bro Frew joined Greenock Kilwinning No 12 in March 1882, and while resident in Greenock was chaplain of the Lodge in the affairs of which he took a keen interest.

It was resolved that a letter be sent to Mrs. Frew and family condoling with them in their sorrow.


