#### A Dip into our History

Recently at the General Committee we have been discussing the replacement of Lodge equipment. Of course, this is an ongoing process and it has ever been thus. In my researches into the Lodge history, I found the following in the minutes about equipment replacement in the 1930s.

### General Committee Meeting Tuesday 1st November 1938

Bro John Conn Chief Steward spoke of the necessity of providing two decanters to replace breakages and this was met by an offer of one each from Bros Owen Dewar PM and AFR Caird IPM. Bro Caird stipulated that his should be exclusively used for port.

Now that is a real touch of class from Bro Caird, I'd say!

The photograph below shows Bro Arthur FR Caird in the centre (in the wickerwork chair) as RWM in 1936-37. It is thought that the photograph was taken in the Lorne Restaurant in West Blackhall Street at the pre-installation reception for office bearers. The Lorne was above what is now the British Heart Foundation furniture shop.

Bro Arthur FR Caird was, of course, a member of the Caird shipbuilding family which owned the shipyard on Dalrymple Street beside the old Albert Harbour and engineering works on Arthur Street. When he joined No XII in 1928 he gave his occupation as 'Manufacturer'.
