From the old minute books of No XII

We have more about RWM Bro RL Scott and his friend Bro Major Playfair, member of No XII and RWM of the Lodge to which he had affiliated in Fife, Lodge Elgin No 91.

We heard about Bro Playfair from Bro Drew McKenzie PM (Crawfurdsburn Greenock No 1121) when he gave us his Lecture on RL Scott a couple of years ago in the Lodge.

Bro Major Playfair is working the 3rd Degree along with what is probably a mutual friend, Bro I Inglis of Lodge Canongate Kilwinning No 2 in Edinburgh.

Br I Inglis IPM Lodge No 2 Elected an Honorary Member

The RWM stated that Bro I Inglis IPM of Lodge Canongate Kilwinning No 2, Edinburgh, who was well known as a most enthusiastic mason had kindly consented to work the 3rd Degree on this occasion with Bro Major Playfair, RWM Lodge Elgin No 91 and he had much pleasure in proposing that Bro Inglis be elected and Honorary Member of this Lodge. Bro Buchanan SW seconded and the motion was cordially agreed to.

Raised Bro Percy Harmon

Thereafter the Lodge was Passed to the FC Degree and was thence Raised to the 3rd Degree when Bro Percy Harmon who had served a regular apprenticeship and passed some time as a Fellow Craft was Raised to the Sublime Degree of Master Mason. The working of the degree by Bros Inglis and Playfair was most

impressive and the Brethren followed the proceedings with intense interest. Well-deserved Votes of Thanks were accorded to these Brethren and thereafter the Lodge was closed in due and ancient form.
