XII is never too far from my mind, and I thought of Rev. Whitehead's words and the time that I have spent in the Lodge since I joined in 1974. It is cracking on for 50 years which have flown by and which, these days, are flying ever more quickly. This is all the truer for those, like me, who have futures that are mostly behind them.

However, my (almost) 50 years pales into insignificance compared to the history of No. XII. Of course, it stretches back to 1728 and consequently on 27<sup>th</sup> December this year the Lodge will celebrate its 295<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

This means that the Lodge celebrates it 300<sup>th</sup> Birthday or Tercentenary in 2028. Ach, 5 years is a long time – but it isn't. Preparations have already begun. At our recent General Committee Meeting were discussing the final version of the Jewel that will be struck to commemorate the occasion. I have been authorised to get the drawing of this final version and to get the Jewels ordered.

We have decided that we shall have a new Lodge carpet in the run up to the occasion, the present one having been bought some 60 years ago in the late 1950s and having seen better days. Its time has flown too! You will hear more and more about this Grand Occasion in the weeks and months to come. Get that date in your diary – 27<sup>th</sup> December 2028. What a birthday party that will be...
